DUTIES

- Assist customers in selecting required parts, suggest companion requirements, offer specials, and ensure the customer is exposed to the full product line.
- Interact with the Service Team to coordinate parts for vehicle repair and service.
- Set up orders for daily shipment, delivery, or pickup
- Perform other department duties such as stocking parts, pulling/shipping returns, and warranty scrapping/returning.

Automotive Technician:

- Utilize product and technical training as assigned by the manufacturer and management
- Participate in manufacturer-sponsored training programs and schools to continuously expand your knowledge of new technology
- Maintain manufacturer (CSI) Customer Satisfaction Index at or above the specified goal(s)
- Complete the work, notations and time-keeping necessary to the successful completion of warranty repair orders and the filing of warranty claims
- Report to management any situation or condition that would jeopardize the safety, welfare, or integrity of the dealership, its customers or employees
- Perform all levels of diagnosis and repair on automobile, light truck vehicles, and RVs
